Rising Up!



The RISE UP project is transforming Chaurjahari Municipality, Rukum West, by promoting disability inclusion. Over the last 6 months, it has been working with **14** disability and **14** mothers' groups, supporting schools in awareness efforts, and provided assistive devices to over **10** individuals. Additionally, **12** official disability ID cards were issued and **48** beneficiaries are receiving regular therapy and counseling, and accessible IEC materials and radio jingles are helping reshape perceptions. Furthermore, strong municipal collaboration is empowering inclusive governance, inspiring leadership among people with disability, and amplifying their voices for lasting change.

Community Health in Lamjung



This past quarter, HDCS–Namuna Community Hospital led impactful health initiatives across Lamjung District to promote well-being and health. A disaster and health awareness program reached **152** individuals, while eye and dental check-ups benefited **408** students in Sundarbazar. A joint health camp with the ward-2 office served **49** people. NCH also supported a blood donation and health check-up campaign, collecting **75** pints.

Recently, two dedicated teachers marked their birthdays by treating all students to a delicious, wholesome meal, turning their special day into a celebration of care and connection.



CORIN – Staff at our radio stations continue to make meaningful strides in amplifying community voices. Through heartfelt storytelling and consistent outreach, they foster connection, care, and support especially for those most in need. *Dhristikon*, meaning perspective, is a radio program that shares the lived experiences of families, with a special focus on elderly. By retelling their struggles and stories with dignity and empathy, *Dhristikon* has successfully mobilized community support and compassion.

KISC EQUIP, in the last quarter, reached **3,737** people across their projects in Lamjung, Siraha, Kathmandu Valley and Rukum West. Some of the activities covered were providing training and support to student school leaders, subject specific training to teachers, workshop for parents and physical education kits and other essential resources to several schools.



FOREBER project moves forward with the signing of an agreement with Kathmandu University for the repair and maintenance of hydrometeorological stations and monitoring of discharge measurements in the Marsyangdi River. This partnership ensures a meaningful step toward strengthening early warning systems in Manang.

In a remote corner of Bafikot-4, Rukum West, the Rijal family's story is a testament to the life-saving power of timely, accessible, and compassionate healthcare. Pratik and Nabina Rijal, now proud parents of three sons, recently welcomed twin baby boys -born prematurely at just 33 weeks - into the world through the skilled hands of our dedicated hospital team at Chaurjahari Hospital Rukum.

Nabina had never delivered in a hospital before. She was referred to us from the District Hospital of Rukum West, arriving with uncertainty, yet hopeful. She gave birth to twin boys who had low birth weight. Under the watchful care of our pediatric unit, the newborns received oxygen therapy and essential medication to stabilize their delicate health. For five days, the hospital became a haven of healing, offering not just medical intervention, but hope, dignity, and reassurance to a family in need.

Today, the Rijal family returns home with hearts full of gratitude and arms full of life. And in a beautiful twist of fate, all three brothers share the same birth date, quaranteeing a bond that will forever connect them in love and resilience.
